## Luca Piovesan - accordion

Luca Piovesan is an accordionist, researcher, sound engineer, and sound artist based in Brussels. He graduated with honors from the Conservatory in Milan, and holds a bachelor in Italian Literature (University of Venice), a diploma in sound engineering (Audiofficine), and he is currently a PhD researcher at VUB investigating processes of musical co-creation. Luca focuses on the many possibilities of the accordion in contemporary music, cooperating with composers and performers. He also explores different repertoires and stages (theatre, klezmer, free improvisation, sound art, chamber music) in order to improve his expressive tools and thus brings the freshness and energy of his kaleidoscopic instrument to the listener. He regularly plays with Ictus, "Promenade Sauvage", "a few minutes to silence", and Sadie Fields. He has performed in the USA (Harvard University, Berklee College of Music, Boston University, Mata Festival NY, Minneapolis University), Belgium (Bozar, Theatre National, Brussels Philarmonic Orchestra), Austria (Konzerthaus Wien, Wiener Festwochen), Germany (Bayreuther Festspiele),



Japan (Tokyo Opera City Hall, Yokohama Hall), France (Opera de Lille, Théâtre National de Strasbourg, MC93), Portugal (Théâtre National de Porto, Culturgest Lisboa), Switzerland (La Via Lattea Lugano, Festival Archipel Genève), Italy (Teatro la Fenice, Teatro Massimo di Palermo), Canada, Netherlands (IIC Amsterdam, Deventer Festival) and Romania (Timisoara University). He is the author of the project [accordion4composers], a free PDF book with audio samples intended to explain to composers how to write for accordion. His latest discs are Helsinki (Bandcamp),

Palhaço (BlowOutRecords, Italy), Sul Tasto (Col Legno, Austria), Maintenance Hums (Carrier Records, USA) and Novus (Stradivarius, Italy).

He teaches Music technology at the Koninklijk Conservatorium Brussel.

He is also a refined audio engineer and artistic director at his *BlowOutStudio*.

He is a tireless traveler, engaged in green mobility projects as a bike mechanic in participative ateliers and as a bike trainer for newbies.
